"IRT": means the IRT Antoine de Saint Exupéry.

3. FORMATION OF THE CONTRACT

- 3.1 The signature of the Form by the duly entitled representative of the Participant shall constitute the Participant's unreserved acceptance of these terms and conditions and a contract shall be deemed to be formed as a result of this acceptance, without prejudice to the right of the IRT to refuse the participation of the Participant at its entire discretion. In absence of written confirmation from the IRT the participation is not quaranteed.
- 3.2 Unless expressly agreed in writing by the IRT, any mention relating to the application of the Participant's general terms and conditions of purchase in any exchange or on any document sent to the IRT before and/or after the Event shall be deemed unwritten and shall not have any effect between the Parties.

4. COMMUNICATION - RIGHTS GRANTED.

The signature of the Form by the duly entitled representative of the Participant expressly grants to the IRT, for the communication of the Event, a right, of representation and reproduction of the logo, video, card or any element described in the selected offer. The Participant undertakes to transfer to the IRT the aforementioned elements at least fifteen (15) calendar days before the Event. Unless otherwise agreed in writing between the Parties, the Fee shall be paid at the latest fifteen (15) calendar days before the date of the Event.

5.2 Any amount not paid on the due date may give rise to the application by the IRT of a late payment fee corresponding to three (3) times the legal interest rate. In addition, a flat-rate indemnity for recovery costs will be payable in accordance with articles L441-6 and D441-5 of the French Commercial Code. Failure by the Participant to pay on the due date may result, without prior formal notice, in the immediate suspension of the access to the Event for the Participant, without prejudice to the right of the IRT to terminate the Contract for the Participant's default.

WARRANTIES

- 6.1 The IRT guarantees that the Event will be organised and executed by competent personnel and in accordance with the best practices in the field concerned on the date of entry into force of the Contract.
- 6.2 In the unlikely circumstances of the Event being cancelled, the IRT will automatically make a full refund of the Fee to the Participant but disclaim any further liability associated therewith.

7. RESPONSIBILITY

- 7.1 The IRT bears no responsibility concerning the identity of the final participants, the scientific or technical quality of the Event, or the success of the Event.
- 7.2 Information disclosed during the Event is provided on an "as is" basis, without any guaranty of any kind whatsoever (including the guarantee of non-infringement of third party patents or any other intellectual property rights of third parties, the guarantee of safety, the guarantee of fitness of such information for a particular purpose).
- 7.3 Unless otherwise imposed by public order provisions, the total liability of the IRT for all types of claims, for all losses and damages resulting from or related to the Event, shall in no case exceed the amount of the Fee actually paid by the Participant. The Participant, its employees, agents, subcontractors, and their respective insurers, waive all claims against the IRT, its employees, agents, subcontractors, and their respective insurers, in excess of the liability limit referred to in this article. 8. CONTRACT TERMINATION BY THE PARTICIPANT

The Participant may terminate the Contract by prior written notice to the IRT. In the event of termination less than fifteen (15) calendar days before the Event, the Participant will not be reimbursed.

9. PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

The IRT undertakes to comply with all applicable regulations on the protection of personal data. Details you have provided in the Form will be used by the IRT solely for administrating your order and your participation in the Event.

10. LITIGATIONS

The Contract is subject to French law.

In the event of a dispute relating to the interpretation or performance of the Contract, the Parties shall first endeavour to resolve the dispute amicably within ten (10) days of the date of notification of the dispute by one Party to the other Party. If no amicable resolution is reached, the dispute will fall under the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent French court.
